



# Botswana - Okavango

## Horse Safari with JNBT

### 31.03 - 05.04.2025



Once again, we are happy to invite you - together with our local partner David Foot Safaris - to **an absolutely unique** expedition - a horse safari in the Okavango Delta in Botswana. This largest inland river delta in the world is one of the greatest sanctuaries of untouched nature. It is called the Jewel of the Kalahari and is included on the UNESCO World Heritage List. Considered one of the seven wonders of Africa. The Okavango Delta provides water for hundreds of thousands of animals coming here from dry regions of Africa. Also called "the gateway to wild Africa, where extraordinary emotions, face-to-face encounters with wild animals, the peace of a secluded delta and wonderful natural beauty await the still few travelers."

We start and end the safari in Maun. All accommodation takes place in tents in the park. Horse riding in the park takes place every day - you can also go on a walking safari on a chosen day and test your tracking skills ☺. The route depends on the water level. A typical day is an early wake-up and breakfast at sunrise, a trip to meet fauna and flora, return for lunch and a siesta in the shade, an afternoon drive in the soothing peace of the Delta and dinner under the stars (sometimes in the quite close company of wild animals ☺). The safari is intended not only for riders - for non-riding companions, we offer the opportunity to participate in a walking safari at the same time.

It is also possible to take part in the L3 JNBT training in Maun before the safari (March 28<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup>) - then the trip to Botswana can be made together with the trainer.

- ❖ horse with tack and saddlebags
- ❖ park entry and camping fees
- ❖ food (meals and non-alcoholic beverages)
- ❖ 6 nights in tents
- ❖ luggage transportation
- ❖ guides and service
- ❖ transfer from/to Maun on the day of start/end of the safari
- ❖ coaching care of the JNBT Academy Master Trainer
